

Recognition of Prior Learning Assessments – Fee Structure

The RPL Assessment fee structure has changed. The coach will now pay one payment only at the start of the process rather than two or more (previously administration costs, technical membership fees plus costs for completing some online courses).

The new fee structure covers the following costs:

- Technical Membership (where applicable)
- Technical Membership benefits pack (sent on completion of RPL process)
- MRC Online Course (free access provided to the course)
- Intermediate / Advanced Online Course (access provided to the most appropriate course so that the coach can access GA resources, and coach according to Australian best practice)
- Visit by an Assessor to observe and assess the coach working in the gym

Please note that costs to gain a First Aid Certificate if required are not included in the fees. This is the responsibility of the coach.

A coach who already holds a FIG Level 2 or Level 3 Academy Accreditation will only be required to pay the Technical Membership fee.

¹ A Coach can either apply for an exemption to the Beginner Coach Accreditation or complete the online and face to face course.

² A local coach must complete the training program as delivered by Gymnastics Australia.

³ The fee due will be based on the level of the full Gymsport Accreditation received. In total a coach will pay the equivalent of the cost of a full accreditation.

⁴ GA or State/Territory Association can give the coach a Beginner Coach Accreditation to allow the coach to work under supervision. This will be updated once an assessment at a higher level is complete.

⁵ In addition to this fee, the Coach must pay for and complete the First Aid requirement.
