

## Acrobatic (ACR) Judging Pathway

All acrobatic judges will follow the pathway below. In most instances a judge will move from one accreditation to the next. Only under special circumstances can a judge miss an accreditation level.

The table gives an overview of what will be covered in the course. For example, a Beginner Judge will learn how to accurately judge the execution of skills in the compulsory routines for levels 1-3 of the Australian Levels Program (ALP), formerly the National Levels Program.
