

Competition Sanction Officer Selection Criteria

To become a Volunteer Competition Sanction Officer for Club and Regional competitions held in NSW you must meet a number of eligibility and selection criteria before being confirmed by the GNSW Competition Sanction Officer and CEO.

The Competition Sanction Officer eligibility criteria are;

- Be a current registered member of GNSW
- and
- Not have any outstanding debts or monies owing to GNSW
- and
- Minimum five years experience in gymnastics competitions as a coach, judge or club owner
- and
- Be a current member of a Gymsport SMC
- or
- Be a current Regional Supervisor
- or
- Be a current member on a regional committee

If you don't meet any of the last four eligibility criteria however would like to be a competition sanction officer you will be selected based on the following selection criteria;

- The number of years experience in gymnastics competitions as a coach, judge or club owner
- Been endorsed by a regional committee via a written reference
- Been endorsed by a gymsport SMC via a written reference

In the case you are confirmed as a Competition Sanction Officer of Gymnastics NSW you agree to abide by the Association's bylaws to undertake the following duties acting with 'good faith and loyalty', showing a duty of 'reasonable care, skill and diligence' in the best interests of Gymnastics NSW. The duties required of a Competition Sanction Officer include but are not limited to;

- Venue and equipment inspection and approval which can take the form of a Club visit or through the sighting and approval of a venue's facility and equipment maintenance records updated within the previous 12 months
- Assist the host Club/Region fill out all competition sanctioning application forms if required and forward a copy to GNSW
- Liaising with the host Club/Region to ensure judging panels meet the required standards for the competition being held
- Assisting the host Club/Region complete the post competition report form if required and then approving all aspects of the competition sanctioning process via the sign off box on all the Club/Regions sanctioning forms
- Forward all material once approved by you, the Sanction Officer, to GNSW including judging panels, results, report form and any injury or accident reports
- Answer any questions the host Club/Region may have in regards to the competition sanctioning process
- Any other duties the GNSW Sanction Officer may require your assistance with from time to time
